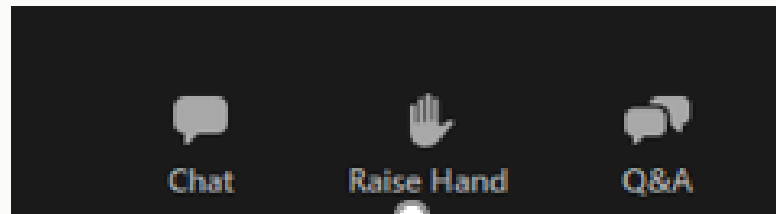




Stephen Gammell
